Historical Data

Chapter One: The Kingdom of Livonia

Livonia (Ливония), officially known as the Kingdom of Livonia (under the Queen Elisia Casamir I), is located in the Baltic Regions between the states of Russia (next to Kaliningrad), Belarus (To her south-east), Lithuania (to her north-east) and Poland (to her south-west). A rather small region known for their mass open fields and illustrious forests with the river Biela and Krust with a territory of 45,300 km² and a population of an estimated 7 million people living in the country. Livonia is seen as Europe's 33rd largest country.

The people of Livonia have a vast and long history within their lands. While there is little to no information on the Pre-Dark Era, the earliest known written document about Livonia along with Lithuania was in the Quedlinburg Chronicles. These were done by Saint Bruno where they were quoted as the "Litua" in Latin. These people were groups of multiple different tribal groups: "Old Prussian/ Sudovians and some early Lithuanians. The modern-day name of Livonia and the Livonian people was first seen by German scholars from the HRE (Holy Roman Empire) for the crusader state known as the Livonian Order and the later known as the Livonian Confederation (They have very little to do with the Livonian order besides their ties to the Teutonic order). However, it was originally seen as part of the territory of the Teutonic Order.

The Sudovians were known as fierce folk, often used as mercenary forces for many nations around the area and especially for the early first "Rus" along with other Germanic clans against the Romans after the fall of the Roman Empire. They were heavily skilled in warfare along with a strong hunter/gatherer upbringing due to the vast forestation and wildlife in the Livonian region, even taking an active part in the Prussian Uprising against the invading Teutonic Crusaders.

Chapter Two: The Commonwealth

Livonia formed part of the Polish-Lithuanian Commonwealth during their union in statehood. It proved to be a period of prosperity and mass migration for within their territories. While Livonia was never fully annexed into the Polish or Lithuanian kingdoms and maintained their feudal lineage of the "Branzow " it was respected as a semi-autonomous state within the Commonwealth. Having the same rights as both of the other nations had during that time. The Livonians began their fortifications (Castles) against the possible invasion threats of the newly created Prussian's against their borders, along with training of an advanced military of Pikemen to combat alongside the Polish Winged Hussars. In this period, the castle of Branzow was constructed along with other castles in Livonia on the Prussian Border.

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Chapter Three: The Monarchy

During the 19th century, there were multiple nationalist uprisings from within the Livonian territories. The most famous was during the Spring of Nations (The revolutions of 1848 were on both ends Livonian nationalists rose up against their oppressors and attempted to form a liberal Livonian state, led by famous revolutionaries such as Adrian Czar, Kosma Dankowski and Sara Brzoza. With initial success and supporting the Polish revolutionaries, these people wanted to bring back the initial constitution of 1808, along with the restoration of the monarchy under Friedrich Casamir (son of Otto Casamir).

Unlike their neighbours to the southwest, Livonia took a cautious approach to post-Soviet politics. In the wake of Glasnost, Perestroika, and the dissolvment of the Soviet Union, Livonia held its first free parliamentary elections in 1991, two years after other countries in the region began their own political discourse. Previously suppressed political ideologies began resurfacing, though the long-standing rule of communism in the region drove the country towards a rise in democratic and monarchical ideas. This political push in Livonia saw the establishment of a Constitutional Monarchy by the year 1995. Stepping into power together, the Casamir dynasty, under King Gustav Casamir, and the Partia Demokratycznej Wolności began Livonia's transition from a country crippled by the Soviet Union to a thriving, active democracy.

Prologue

Chapter One: Harvest Red – (October 2009)



In October 2009, at the request of the Chernarussian government-in-exile, the United States was authorised to dispatch intervention forces to the region of South Zagoria in north-eastern Chernarus. Pro-Russian separatists known as the "Chernarussian Movement of the Red Star" or "ChDKZ" for short, had executed the incumbent Prime Minister of Chernarus and overrun the province.

During an operation called "Harvest Red" meant to weaken separatist coastal defences, US Marine forces discovered evidence of torture and genocide at the hands of the ChDKZ. While US forces attempt to unite the Chernarussian military (CDF) with National Party (NAPA) loyalist guerrillas, a bombing takes place in Red Square, Moscow, Russia further escalating the conflict. ChDKZ separatists blame the bombing on the National Party, leading to the Russian Federation calling for the withdrawal of US forces from Chernarus. As their mandate ended, the US military eventually was forced to withdraw. It was during this time that it was discovered by a remaining US strike team that the bombing in Moscow was a false flag operation by the ChDKZ to frame the National Party. In the following week, Gregori "Akula" Lopotev, the leader and co-founder of ChDKZ, was arrested by US forces and handed over to the Russian military for interrogation. This marked the end of the conflict, as Russian forces agreed to withdraw from the region.



Chapter Two: Post Civil-War (2010-18)

Chernarus had made great strides in rebuilding since the conclusion of the bloody 2009 civil war and was on route to becoming something of a power in the region. While Chernarus had not officially joined NATO for fear of losing national sovereignty, it did agree to host several bases within Chernarus. International Airports were expanded allowing flights heading to Asia or back to Western Europe to stop and refuel at a central place without having to fly to Dubai for a connecting flight.

In the wake of the civil war NAPA was disbanded by leader Josef Prizak and most of its members joined the CDF and accepted general amnesty from the government. The Chedaki were hunted down viciously by the State, capturing all of its leadership that was not apprehended or killed during the civil war and put them on trial. Many were executed for the genocide, insurrection, and murder conducted during the war. Despite Chernarussian-Russian relations being quite amicable immediately following the civil war, tensions would again rise to a boiling point between the two countries. Even with the election of a popular centre-right statist nationalist party and a booming economy, military escalation was a frequent occurrence on the northern border. A marriage between a Chernarussian woman and a Russian man was attacked by right sector Chernarussian extremists in late April 2017. The attack was followed by protests, political demonstrations, and calls for secession of ethnic Russian territories in Northern South Zagoria and Belozersk. Ultimately the violence led the State to declare martial law in South Zagoria on May 3rd, 2017. The province was gripped with fear and tension and some citizens left to go to western areas that were considered to be safe, their belongings and vehicles left behind to rot, for fear of another civil war. However, the attention of the world was focused elsewhere and not on the developing situation in Chernarus.

Season One – (2019)

Chapter One: Origins



It all began with seemingly benign activity at an old storage base north of Severograd, the easternmost base in a chain of facilities that stretched West along the Black Mountains. After the fall of the USSR and rise of Chernarussian independence the base was handed over to the fledgling CDF, any memory of the base and its activities were forgotten. The sites were sealed to the public during Soviet times and the local populace knew little of the activities of these bases.

On the 7th of July CDF troops were sent to the base where they established a series of checkpoints on surrounding roads, stopping all foot or vehicle traffic and turning it back. A video filmed of a Russian helicopter flying into the base was posted on Twitter the same night, igniting controversy. The following day the residents of Kamensk and Nagornoe were rounded up; those from Nagornoe were escorted south to Severograd and housed in the local school without any explanation as to the reason of their relocation other than their “personal safety”. The civilians from Kamensk who the main witnesses to the whole incident were disappeared completely, the most common rumour being that they had been held inside the base itself.

National outrage ensued. In the meantime, events escalated considerably around midnight, when an apparent disagreement between the two sides of the base resulted in the departure of the Russians back across the border. In the early hours of the 10th, the Russian air force completely annihilated the storage base that was the source of the whole controversy, leaving only a couple buildings standing and fifty dead Chernarussian personnel within the base. In response, Chernarussian jets from the Vybor Airbase raided Russian border posts starting a back and forth between each country's military. Chernarus awoke to a war in South Zagoria as national demonstrations and outbursts of violence occurred in the morning.



Chapter Two: The Spread

Severograd began experiencing attacks from several soldiers that appeared to be rabid and unresponsive, the soldiers having emanated from the base. Many were severely burned or partially dismembered, and yet did not seem to care or respond with pain to their injuries. The first call came in from a farm North of the city, reporting three soldiers staggering out of the forest biting and attacking livestock. The station lost contact with the patrol sent to check on the farm. To make matters worse, following the bombing of the base and the subsequent dispersal of CDF troops in the area, Russian artillery launched an all-out bombardment of the Kamensk, Nagornoe, and Severograd countryside. A man in Severograd who was interviewed by a local news station in Novodmitrovsk said the following about that morning:

“The Russian bombardment was a distraction from whatever went on in the base that night. They had some stake in the course of events there, after all the bombardment did little damage to any civilian or military structure. The goal was to distract the international press for as long as possible.”

The Russian ploy worked according to plan as the international news was fixed on the fighting and armed confrontations and not on the strange attacks taking place near the site of the bombing. In the afternoon a wave of infected hit Severograd from the North, overwhelming the already packed hospital. Many of the people brought into the hospital were bleeding from the eyes and had developed rashes similar to poison oak that secreted a clear fluid.



Chapter Three: The Globe

Since the outbreak, most of the world has spiralled into chaos. Larger towns and cities are barely under any governmental control, let alone safe control, and Europe is especially under a lot of stress and is struggling an abnormally large amount. What is left of the governments on the continent have been trying to prioritize certain regions and secure small safe zones for the time being.

Generally, countries and regions with a high population density have been struggling more than countries and regions with a low population density. India and China are considered to be

completely lost, while some islands have been almost untouched by the infection, or if they have been affected, they were able to quarantine and prevent the spread in time.

People across the world have started to travel across borders, legally and illegally, in search of safer places and resources to survive this global pandemic.



Chapter Four: Europe

Due to the heavy population density of Europe, there are only a few successful Quarantine Zones—one in Italy, one in Sweden, and one in Poland. However, there were many tried in all countries. As each one fell, people went in search of a safe haven and tried the other Quarantine Zones until all but three were deemed failures. The one in Poland is being guarded by what remains of European NATO forces that have not deserted; the one in Italy is currently being manned by former military and military who've survived since the outbreak; and the one in Sweden is now being manned by mostly civilians with a few government officials and a sparse number of militaries. Governments in each country have little to no control, if they haven't died out completely—the people look to those who are actively protecting them for guidance rather than the people who they view as having led them into this in the first place.



Chapter Five: Russia

Moscow has been struggling, but still remains under Russian Federation control. The quarantine zones are still holding strong, although resources are beginning to come under attack by hostile militias on their supply routes. Securing supplies, battling the militias, and regaining territory has taken priority these days. St. Petersburg, once a crowning jewel in the Russian Federation has fallen, the city is now ruled by hostile militias and any formal military still in the region have defected or returned to Moscow. The city also has an extremely high amount of infected roaming the streets.

As a city of vital logistical importance in the region, the Russian government diverted extra resources and troops to Sevastopol in February of 2020 to protect its most valuable assets: the Naval Base and the International Airport. Late June 2020, witnesses reported several ships sailing south towards the Bosphorus. Since the bulk of the naval fleet left the city, civilians have been apprehensive with the military forces and government authorities left within the city. The Quarantine Zone (QZ) held within the city has been on the edge of falling apart for months now, the civilians are starting to realize the government isn't going to come and save them. The remains of the Russian forces have gotten word to return to Moscow to continue to hold the city, everyone is expecting something to happen soon.

Sochi, the "Winter Capital" of Russia, has been scrambling for control since the more recent outbreaks of the infection. In January 2020, with the resurgence of the infection in the area, large scale efforts were made to turn the city into a regional relocation and treatment centre; the Olympics facilities serving as a perfect location and arrangement for the "Sochi Quarantine Zone". As the situation continued to deteriorate, despite the local government's attempts at control, the Russian High Command pulled its resources from the city to other interests eastward and the city spiralled into anarchy. After a fire started within the Quarantine Zone spread into the great parts of the city, reducing most of the architecture to ashes, the Russian Federation completely pulled out and left Sochi to fall.

As one of the operating bases of the Russian "Black Sea Fleet", Novorossiejsk's naval facilities were considered too important to fall into militia hands or worse. Defenders set up a Quarantine Zone (QZ) around the main port, abandoning all but the naval infrastructure. Civilians within the city have noticed ships sailing west out of port without any returning.



Chapter Six: North America

While thought to be heavily prepared for something of this nature, the United States of America was among the worst responses in the world. From people calling the entire thing a hoax, to protesting when the government was forced to take action. The quarantine zones in the largest cities in each state were quickly overrun with refugees when the infection spread quickly through smaller towns and cities, and found themselves overwhelmed before they each failed, one after the other. Farming communities seemed to be mostly untouched by the infection, but only because they are spread out among the different regions the US. However, civilians banded together with military that survived the harshness of the outbreak and created pockets of survivors throughout the country. The hope the government will be able to rebuild itself is lost, the US as it was once known has fallen.

Much like the United States, there are pockets of civilization in both Canada and Mexico. The islands in the Caribbean have been almost completely wiped out due to tourism bringing the virus to the islands and little to no assistance being given to them from other countries due to them dealing with their own national pandemics.

Chapter Seven: South America

Larges cities in each country were overwhelmed, much like everywhere else. The quarantine zones lasted for almost 8 months before one by one they all failed, and civilians were forced to fend for themselves or die. Towns and villages situated further away from the large cities remained untouched for the most part. There are some that were infected, but the further away

from a city and a dense population a person is, the less likely they are to get infected.



Season Two – (2020)

Chapter One: The Deadzone

In January of 2020, the Chernarussian government dissolved. The region itself was quarantined, with US and Russian forces patrolling the borders and cutting any of those attempting to escape the turmoil within. With the infection spreading like wildfire within Chernarus, the international community came to call it the Deadzone. Those unlucky enough to have still been inside when the borders were closed now struggle to survive.



Chapter Two: The First Months

In February of 2020, the survivors of the first onslaught of the outbreak sought refuge along the southern coastline, far from the hordes that plagued the north. At a campsite north of Elektro, a small community was scraped together with wood and nails. Before long it became known as Haven, a place of trade and safety from the undead that walked Chernarus.

Throughout its lifetime, Haven has come under attack many times, and nearly every time the citizens of the small village and even survivors from the surrounding region have come to its aid and repelled enemy forces and devious plots. The pub, a central location to the survivors, was even bombed following a dispute.

Soon, the population grew so large that the survivors spilled out and into the surrounding area, taking their cars and hitting the coastal highways intent on finding their wealth and purpose elsewhere. The Elektro district was born, and several other settlements soon followed suit.

West through the forests and north over the hills, the people of the Deadzone have spread. And for some time, all has been well and the borders quiet. But strange transmissions are making their way over the radio waves. The world outside the Deadzone has begun to change.



Chapter Three: End of an Era

For nearly a year, US and Russian forces have patrolled the borders of Chernarus, attempting to contain the infection and violence within. Through combined efforts, their operation has largely been successful.

However, in the early hours of November 2nd, an encoded transmission was captured by American intelligence detailing plans by Russian forces to invade Chernarus and eradicate all infected and any survivors before detonating a nuclear warhead.

The Russian High Command has denied any such cable was sent, but US forces have readied themselves for an attack and are rapidly deploying more troops to the area.

The UN has geared a special extraction plane to be sent into the Deadzone soon to extract any willing survivors before the looming conflict begins.



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Chapter Four: Red Skies

In the final hours before detonation of a nuclear warhead, desperate survivors, looking to survive the coming destruction of Chernarus boarded what they thought was an UN-led aircraft, unaware that it had been violently commandeered. Engine failure in the skies above Livonia caused the plane full of survivors to crash land as it entered the airspace of Gliniska airfield. Out of the frying pan and into the fire, the Red Star B.N.W. project had brought the remaining people of Chernarus into a fresh hell.

As the survivors spread from the northern river and south into the woodlands, rumours of who had brought them there spread just the same. As time passed, people began to disappear. Farmers, traders, people just trying to get by were suddenly gone, their homes left in disarray as if a struggle had taken place. People were afraid to travel for fear of being disappeared. However, a militant group known as JTF rose as an opposing force to this mysterious Red Star. After hearing first hand of the rumours of kidnapping and brainwashing, they began to act. After investigating the area surrounding Kopa prison, the truth of what had been happening became a very real nightmare. War had become something inevitable.

He wasn't himself at all, they knew something wasn't right. The Sheriff blinded by grief and the bottle, conveniently hoodwinked for this new 'leaders' plans.

Miscalculations brought a swift demise to this toxins reign; truths would begin unfurling and identities questioned. Mother earth began to call...



Chapter Two: September

As the attention on much of the Red Star resistance centred around Olszanka, unbeknownst to locals, discreet plans were being made to attack the supply chains and resource of the Livonia Supply Co.

Knowing all too well how events of these nature preceded the September Crisis of 2009 and the subsequent Civil War in Chernarus, The Guardians of Livonia were re-raised to prevent the annexation of Livonia by the Red Star.
